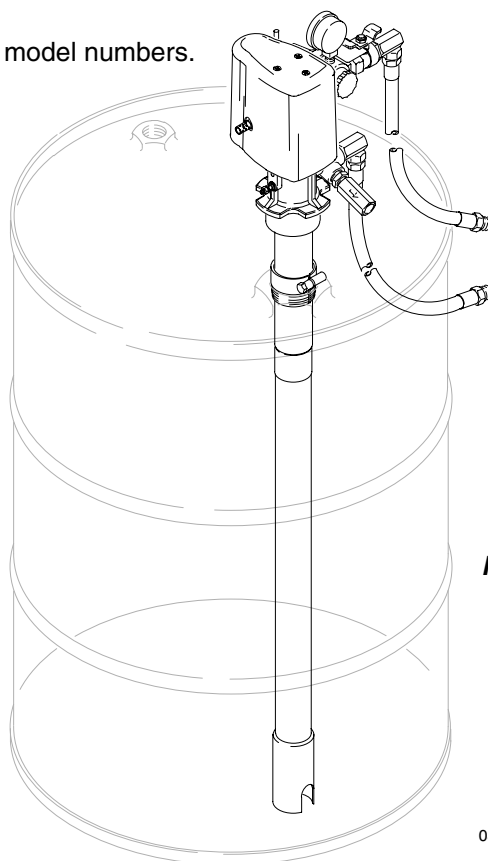

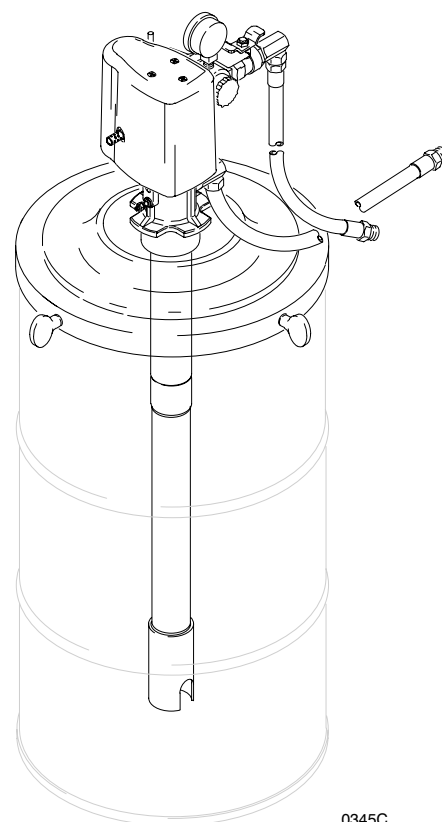

INJECTION HAZARD

Fluid from the valve, leaks, or ruptured components can inject fluid into your body and cause extremely serious injury, including the need for amputation. Fluid splashed in the eyes or on the skin can also cause serious injury.

- Fluid injected into the skin is a serious injury. The injury may look like just a cut, but it is a serious injury. Get immediate medical attention.
- Do not point the valve at anyone or at any part of the body.
- Do not put your hand or fingers over the valve tip.
- Do not stop or deflect leaks with your hand, body, glove or rag.
- Do not “blow back” fluid; this is not an air spray system.
- Follow the **Pressure Relief Procedure** on page 8 before you clean, check, or service the equipment.
- Tighten all fluid connections before operating the equipment.
- Check the hoses, tubes, and couplings daily. Replace worn, damaged, or loose parts immediately. Permanently coupled hoses cannot be repaired; replace the entire hose.



MOVING PARTS HAZARD

Moving parts can pinch or amputate your fingers.

- Keep clear of all moving parts when starting or operating the pump.
- Before checking or servicing the equipment, follow the **Pressure Relief Procedure** on page 8 to prevent the equipment from starting unexpectedly.

FIRE AND EXPLOSION HAZARD

Improper grounding, poor ventilation, open flames, or sparks can cause a hazardous condition and result in a fire or explosion and serious injury.

- Ground the equipment and the object being dispensed to. Refer to **Grounding** on page 9.
- If there is any static sparking or you feel an electric shock while using this equipment, **stop dispensing immediately**. Do not use the equipment until you identify and correct the problem.
- Provide fresh air ventilation to avoid the buildup of flammable fumes from solvents or the fluid being dispensed.
- Keep the dispensing area free of debris, including solvent, rags, and gasoline.
- Do not smoke in the dispensing area.



TOXIC FLUID HAZARD

Hazardous fluid or toxic fumes can cause serious injury or death if splashed in the eyes or on the skin, inhaled, or swallowed.

- Know the specific hazards of the fluid you are using.

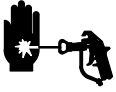

Pressure Relief Procedure

WARNING



INJECTION HAZARD

Fluid under high pressure can be injected through the skin and cause serious injury. To reduce the risk of an injury from injection, splashing fluid, or moving parts, follow the **Pressure Relief Procedure** whenever you

- Are instructed to relieve the pressure
- Shut off the pump
- Check or service any of the system equipment
- Install or change the dispensing nozzles

1. Close the pump air regulator.
2. Close the bleed-type master air valve (required in your system).
3. Hold a metal part of the dispensing valve firmly to the side of a grounded metal waste container, and trigger the valve to relieve fluid pressure.

If you suspect that the dispensing valve, extension, or nozzle is clogged or that pressure has not been fully relieved after following the steps above, very slowly loosen the coupler or hose end coupling and relieve pressure gradually, then loosen it completely, then clear the clog.

Air Line Accessories

Refer to your pump manual 309223 (supplied) for a Typical Installation drawing and information on recommended air line accessories.

WARNING

A bleed-type master air valve is required in your system to help reduce the risk of serious bodily injury including fluid injection, splashing in the eyes or on the skin, and injury from moving parts if you are adjusting or repairing the pump.

The bleed-type master air valve relieves air trapped between this valve and the pump after the air is shut off. Trapped air can cause the pump to cycle unexpectedly. Locate the valve close to the pump.

CAUTION

Thermal expansion of fluid in the outlet line can cause overpressurization. This can occur when using hard-plumbed fluid lines exposed to sunlight or ambient heat, or when pumping from a cool to a warm area (for example, from an underground tank through fluid lines near the ceiling).

If thermal expansion could occur in your system, you must install a 235998 Thermal Relief Kit at the pump outlet to prevent overpressurization and rupture of the pump or hose.

Grounding

**WARNING**

**FIRE AND EXPLOSION HAZARD**
Before operating the pump, ground the system as explained below. See **Fire or Explosion Hazard** on page 5.

To reduce the risk of static sparking, ground the pump. Check your local electrical code for detailed grounding instructions for your area and type of equipment. Be sure to ground all of the dispensing equipment:

- *Pump:* Use a ground wire and clamp as shown in Fig. 1.
- *Fluid hoses:* Use only grounded fluid hoses.
- *Air hoses:* Use only grounded air hoses.
- *Dispensing valve:* Obtain grounding through connection to a properly grounded fluid hose and pump.
- *Fluid supply container:* Follow local code.
- *Air compressor:* Follow local code.
- *To maintain grounding continuity when flushing or relieving pressure,* always hold a metal part of the dispense valve firmly to the side of a grounded metal pail, then trigger the valve.

To ground the pump, loosen the grounding lug locknut (W) and washer (X). Insert one end of a 12-ga (1.5 mm²) minimum ground wire (Y) into the slot in lug (Z) and tighten the locknut securely. Connect the other end of the ground wire to a true earth ground. See Fig 1. *To order a ground wire and clamp, order Part No. 222011.*

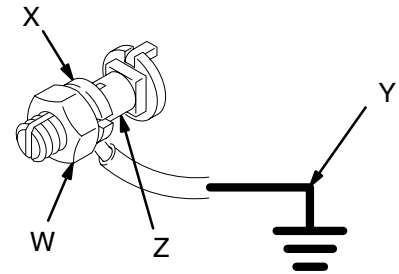

Operating and Service Instructions

Refer to your pump manual 309223 (supplied) for operating and service instructions.

Installation

Model 244085, Universal Pump

1. See Fig. 2. Assemble the air regulator kit (items 3a–3d) to the pump air inlet (A), as shown. Use thread sealant and tighten all parts securely.
2. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 3/8 npt swivel union (2b). Screw the union into the bleed-type master air valve (3c).
3. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 1/2 npt swivel union (2d). Screw the union into the pump fluid outlet (B).
4. Connect the 1/2 npt(mbe) fluid hose (2c) to the swivel union (2d).
5. Connect the 3/8 npt(mbe) air hose (2a) to the swivel union (2b).

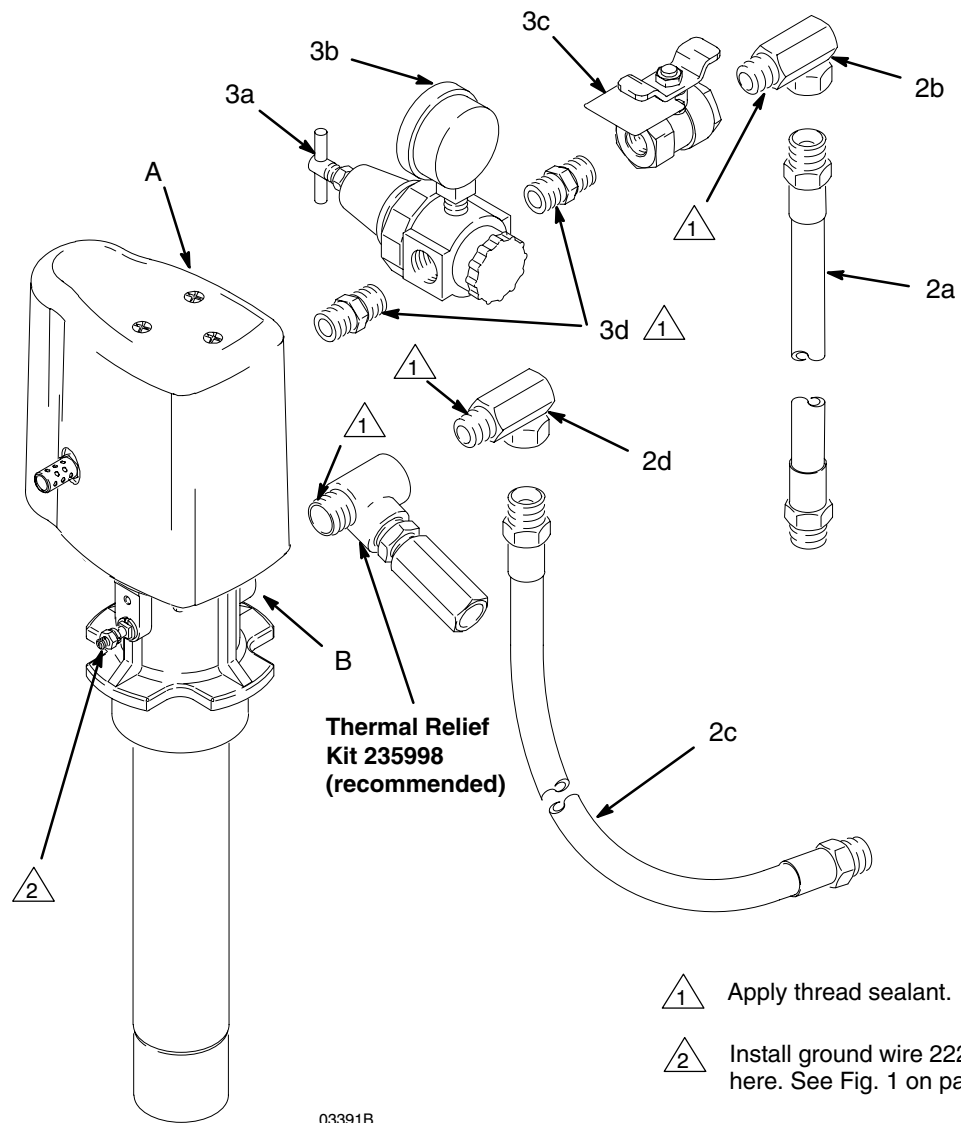

Installation

Model 244086, 16-Gallon (60 Liter) Drum Cover Pump

1. Set the cover (4) on a 16-gallon (60 liter) drum and secure with the thumbscrews (G). See Fig. 3.
2. Install the pump (1) on the cover (4) with the screws (E), washers and nuts (F) supplied.
3. Assemble the air regulator kit (items 3a–3d) to the pump air inlet (A), as shown. Use thread sealant and tighten all parts securely.
4. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 3/8 npt swivel union (2b). Screw the union into the bleed-type master air valve (3c).
5. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 1/2 npt swivel union (2d). Screw the union into the pump fluid outlet (B).
6. Connect the 1/2 npt(mbe) fluid hose (2c) to the swivel union (2d).
7. Connect the 3/8 npt(mbe) air hose (2a) to the swivel union (2b).

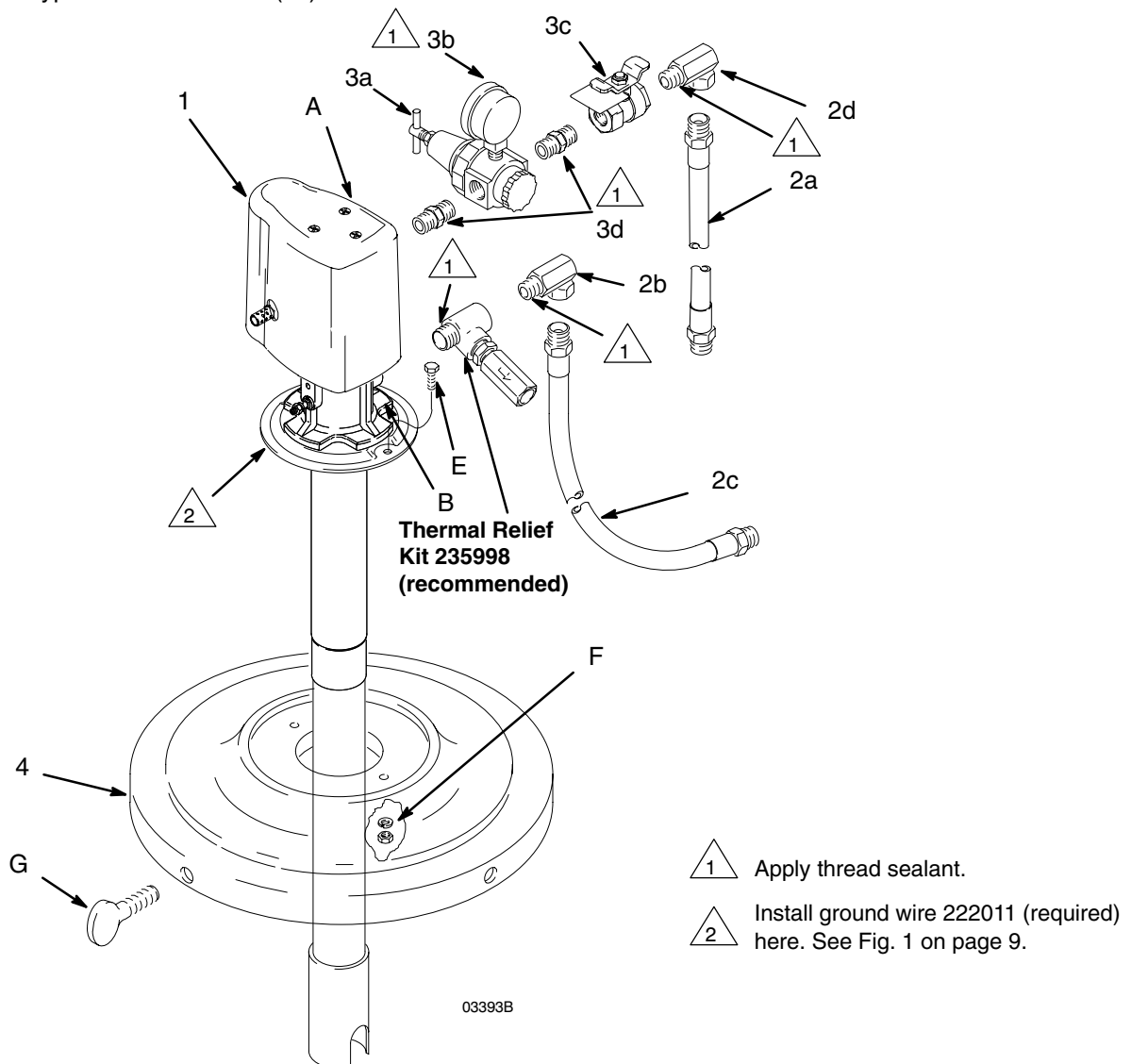

Installation

Model 244087, 55-Gallon (208 Liter) Drum Bung-Mount Pump

1. Screw the bung adapter (C) into the bung hole of the drum. Adjust the pump (1) so its intake is about 1 in. (25 mm) off the bottom of the drum, then tighten the bung adapter screw (D) to hold the pump in position. See Fig. 4.
2. Assemble the air regulator kit (items 3a–3d) to the pump air inlet (A), as shown. Use thread sealant and tighten all parts securely.
3. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 3/8 npt swivel union (2b). Screw the union into the bleed-type master air valve (3c).
4. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 1/2 npt swivel union (2d). Screw the union into the pump fluid outlet (B).
5. Connect the 1/2 npt(mbe) fluid hose (2c) to the swivel union (2d).
6. Connect the 3/8 npt(mbe) air hose (2a) to the swivel union (2b).

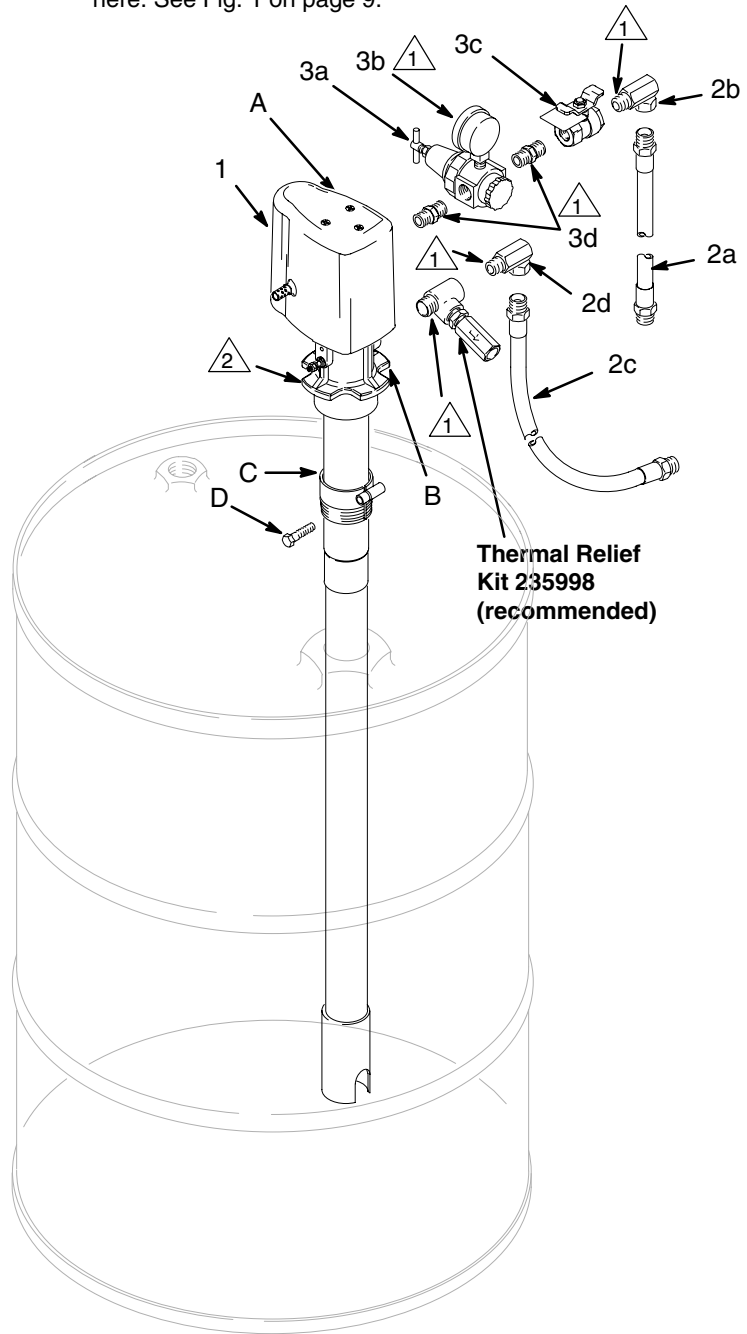

Installation

Model 244088, 55-Gallon (208 Liter) Drum Cover Pump

1. Set the cover (4) on a 55-gallon (208 liter) drum. Install the pump (1) on the cover with the screws (E) supplied. See Fig. 5.
2. Assemble the air regulator kit (items 3a–3d) to the pump air inlet (A), as shown. Use thread sealant and tighten all parts securely.
3. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 3/8 npt swivel union (2b). Screw the union into the bleed-type master air valve (3c).
4. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 1/2 npt swivel union (2d). Screw the union into the pump fluid outlet (B).
5. Connect the 1/2 npt(mbe) fluid hose (2c) to the swivel union (2d).
6. Connect the 3/8 npt(mbe) air hose (2a) to the swivel union (2b).

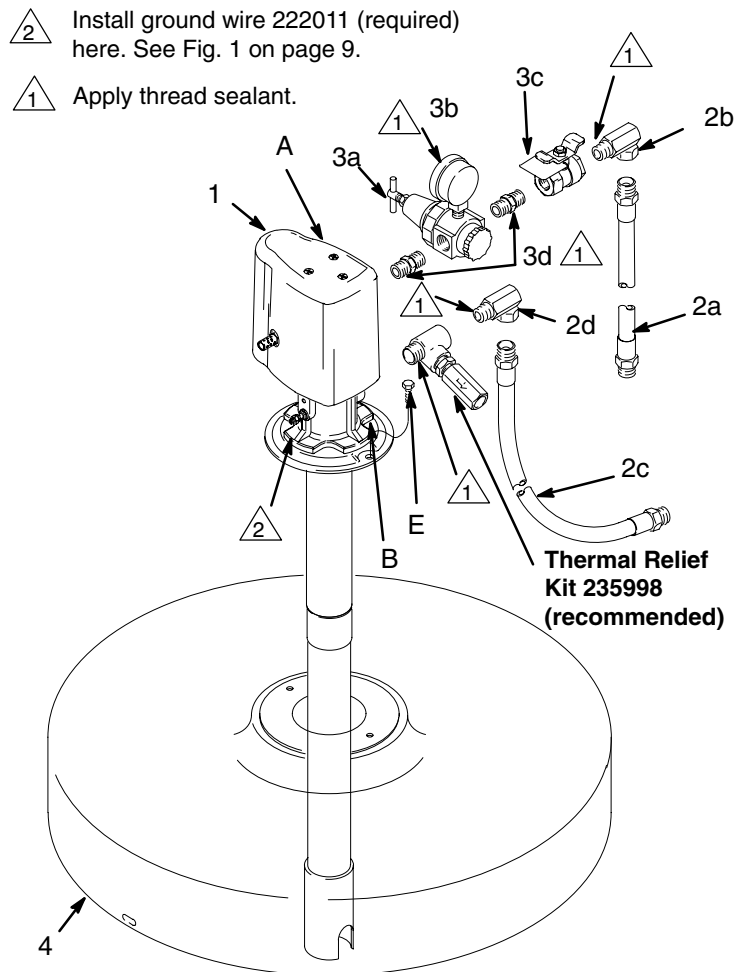

Installation

Model 244089, 275-Gallon (1040 Liter) Tank Bung-Mount Pump

1. Screw the bung adapter (C) into the bung hole of the tank. Adjust the pump so its intake is about 1 in. (25 mm) off the bottom of the tank, then tighten the bung adapter screw (D) to hold the pump in position. See Fig. 6.
2. Assemble the air regulator kit (items 3a–3d) to the pump air inlet (A), as shown. Use thread sealant and tighten all parts securely.
3. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 3/8 npt swivel union (2b). Screw the union into the bleed-type master air valve (3c).
4. Apply thread sealant to the male threads of the 1/2 npt swivel union (2d). Screw the union into the pump fluid outlet (B).
5. Connect the 1/2 npt(mbe) fluid hose (2c) to the swivel union (2d).
6. Connect the 3/8 npt(mbe) air hose (2a) to the swivel union (2b).

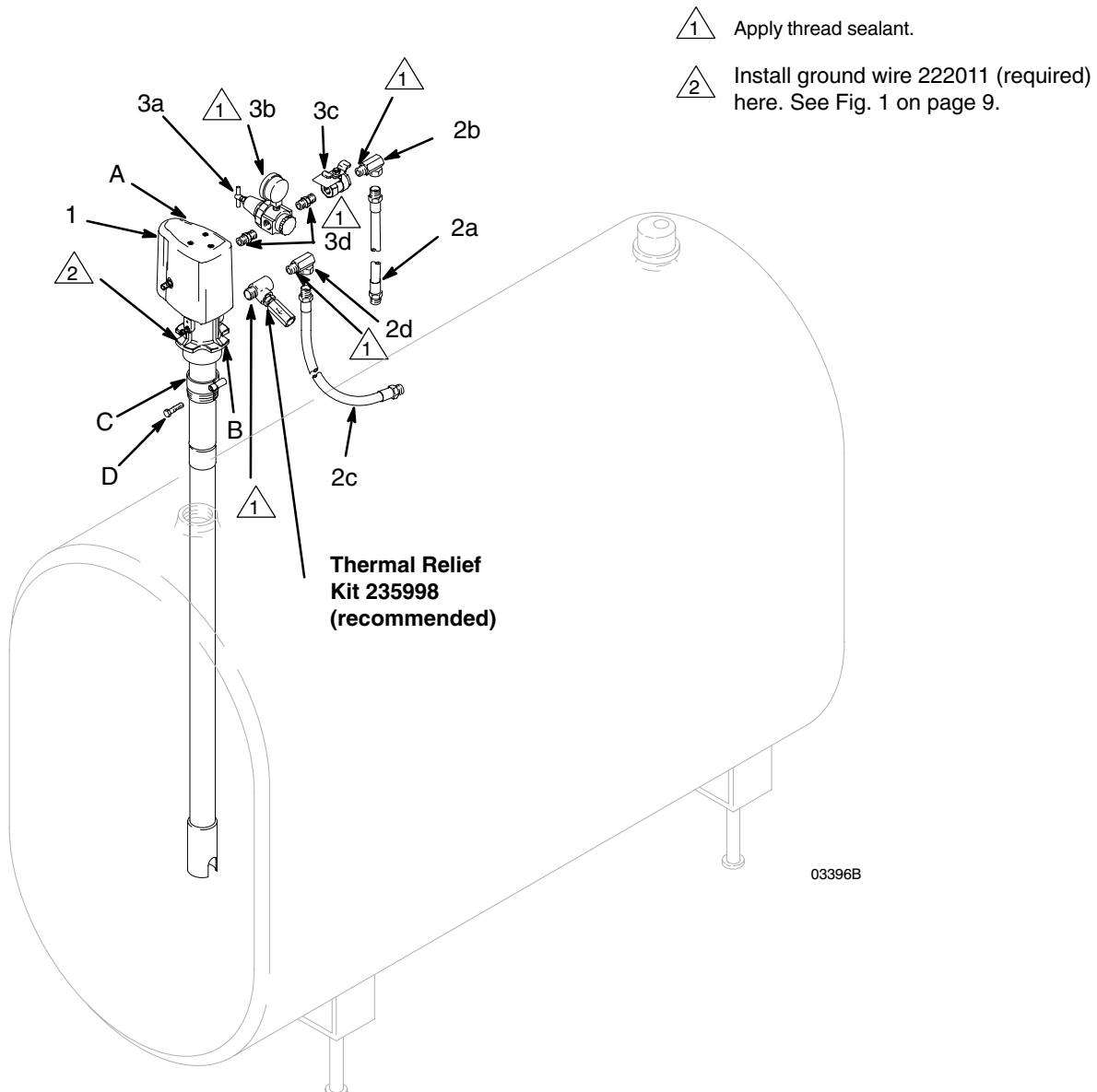

Installation

Model 244094, 16-Gallon (60 Liter) Economy Portable Dispenser

1. Assemble the base (5) as shown in Fig. 7. Place an opened 16-gallon (60 liter) drum of oil on the base, and secure it with the hold-down clamps. Tighten the hold-down clamp bolts.
2. Set the cover (4) on a 16-gallon (60 liter) drum and secure with the thumbscrews (G). Install the pump (1) on the cover (4) with the screws (E), washers and nuts (F) supplied.
3. Install the seal nut (6d), nipple (6c), and meter (6e) in the fluid outlet (B) of the pump (1). Connect the hose (6a) to the meter outlet, then assemble the dispense valve (6b) to the hose.

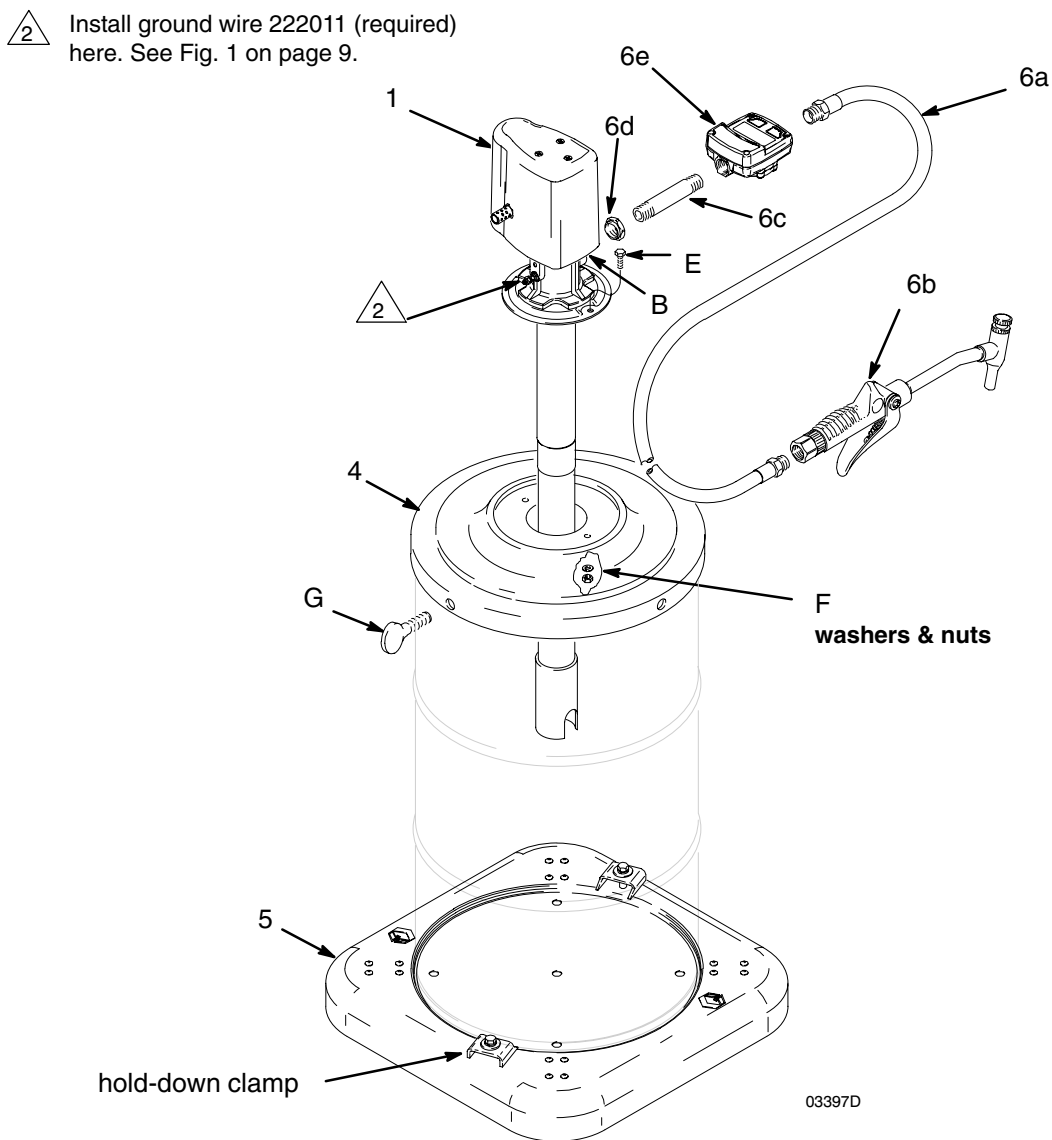


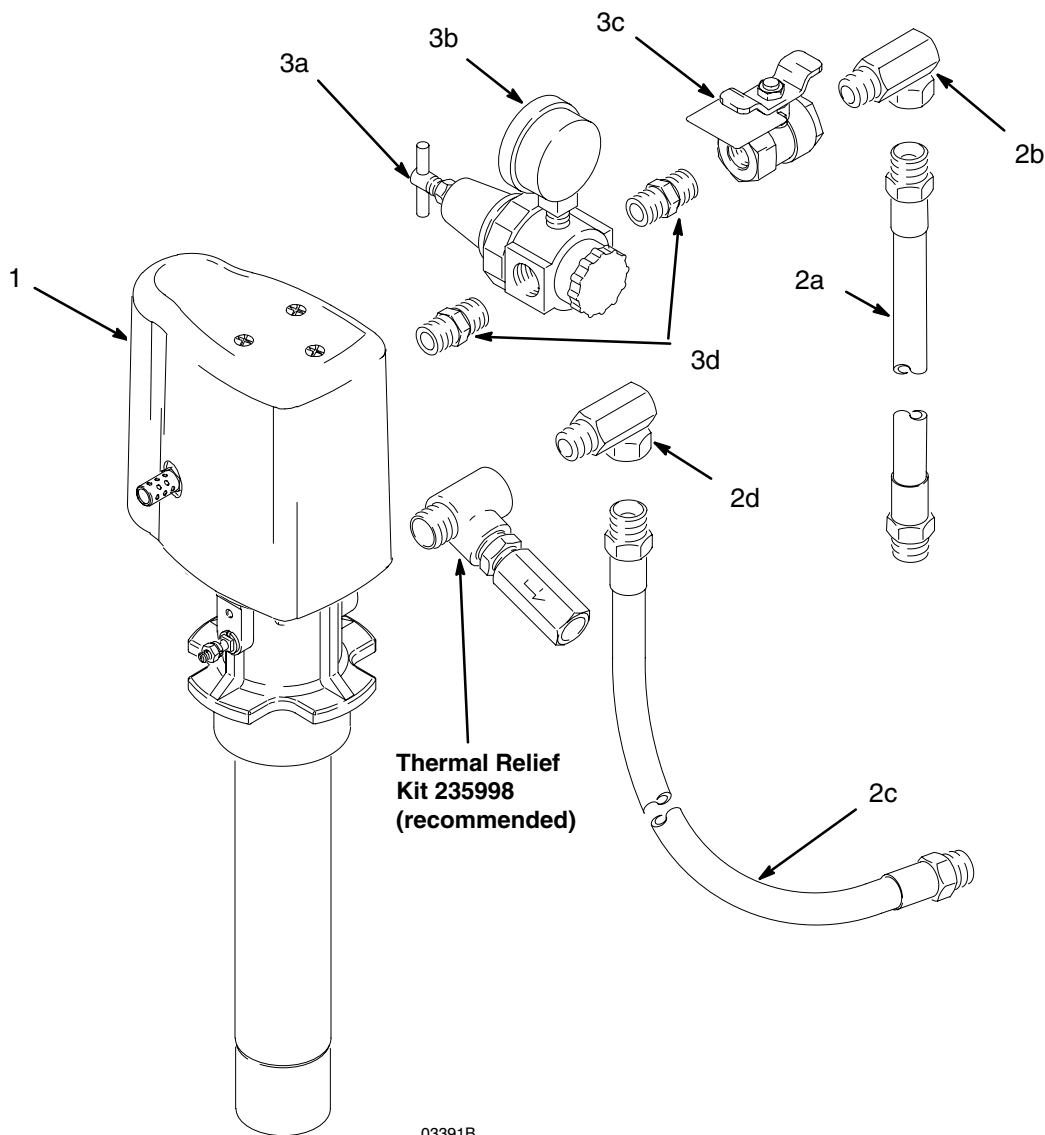

Part of Ref. No. 4, Drum Cover

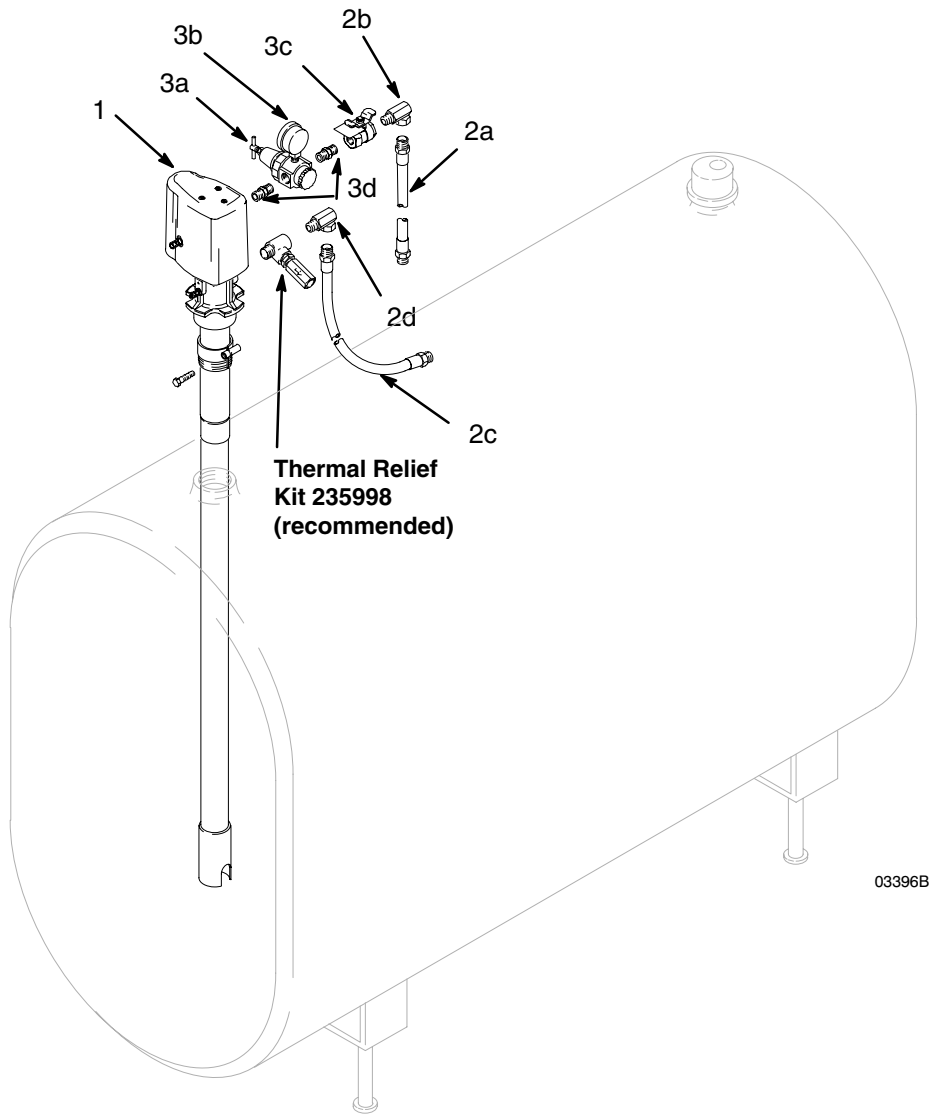

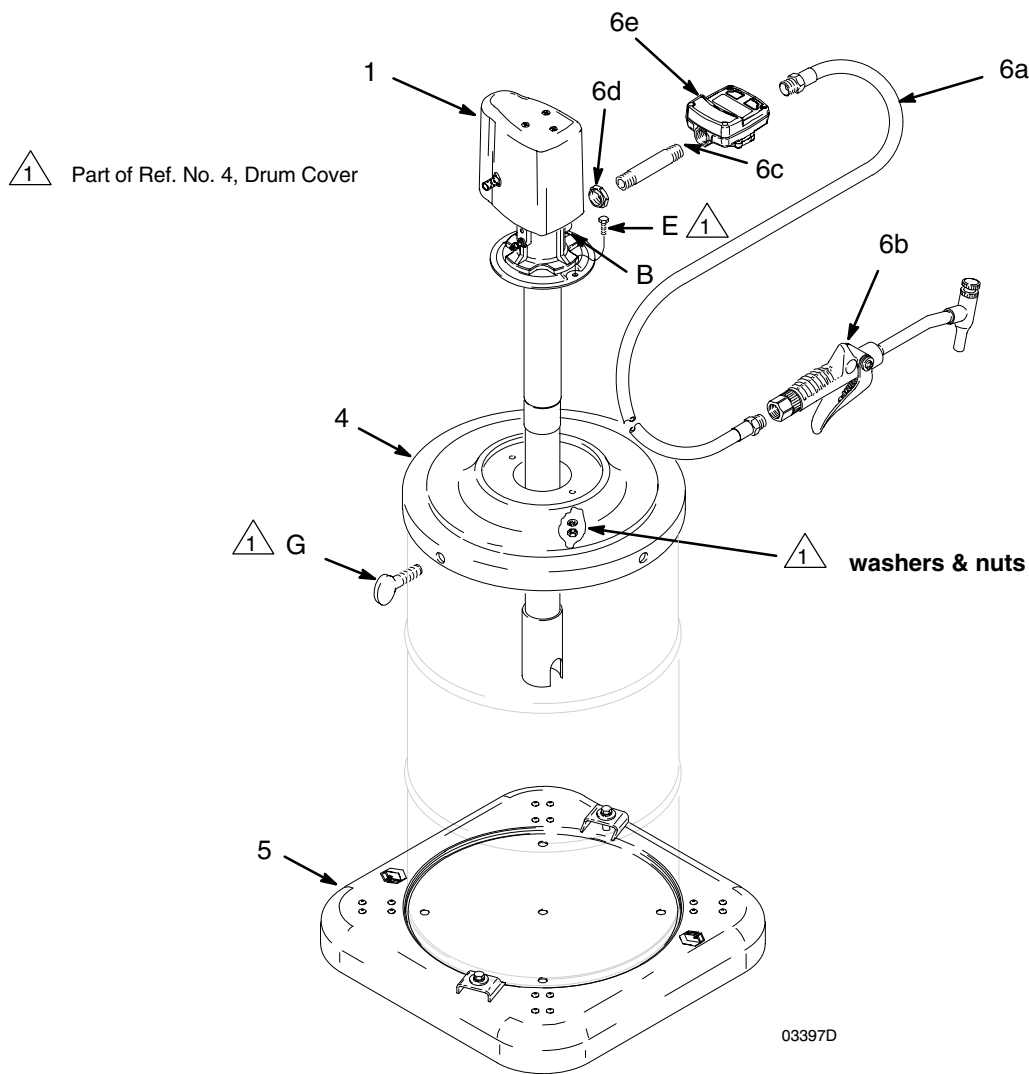
