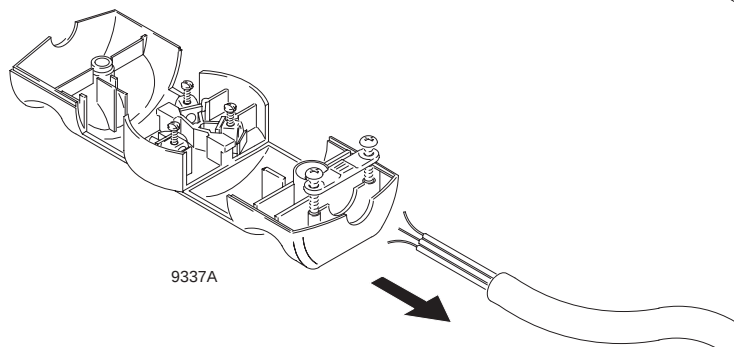
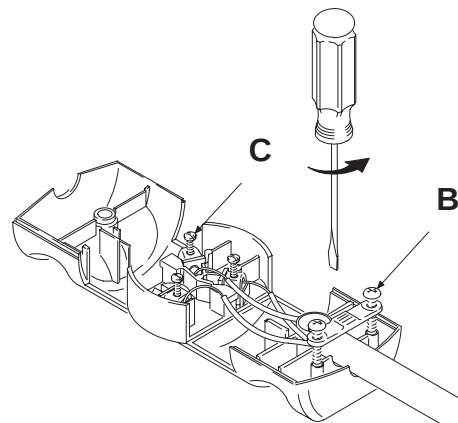
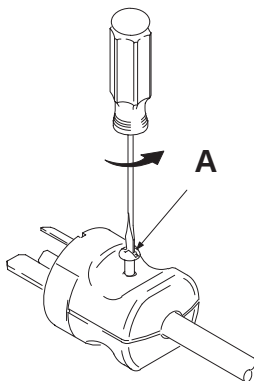
FIRE AND EXPLOSION HAZARD

This power cord is equipped with a plug wired correctly for Australia. Countries that require other plugs must remove this plug and install the correctly wired plug for your country.

1. Loosen screw (A) on top of plug.
2. Loosen two strain relief screws around power cord plug (B).
3. Loosen three screws (C) and remove three leads from plug.
4. Install your plug with the correct polarity for your country.
